



TGA Individual Matchplay Championship

2025 Competition Rules and Format

1. Eligibility

• **Qualification**: The top 32 players from the previous season's Stableford Order of Merit qualify for the championship. *If a qualified player withdraws, their spot will not be filled by another player.*

2. Handicap Regulations

- Valid Handicap Requirement: Participants must maintain a valid handicap throughout the competition, adhering to the World Handicap System as administered by England Golf and (CONGU).
- **Handicap Adjustments**: In each match, the lower-handicap player concedes **85%** of the difference between the players' course handicaps to the higher-handicap player.
- **Monitoring**: The Competition Committee will oversee handicaps and match results to ensure fairness and prevent manipulation.

3. Tournament Format

- **Structure**: The championship follows an Individual Match Play Knockout format.
- **Match Deadlines**: Each of the five rounds must be completed by the end of April, May, June, July, and August, respectively.
- Home Course Advantage:
 - **Rounds 1, 2, 3** A draw will determine the opponents for each round. The first-named player in the draw will select the course for that match.
 - The visiting player receives **one extra handicap stroke** when playing on their opponent's home course.
 - **Semi-Finals**: Matches are drawn and played at a neutral venue arranged by TGA.
 - **Final**: TGA will organise and cover the course selection and associated green fees.

4. Match Arrangement Protocol

- **Joint Responsibility**: Both players are equally responsible for scheduling their match within the specified timeframe.
- **Initial Communication**: Players must initiate contact within seven days of the draw announcement.
- **Proposing Dates**: Each player should suggest three reasonable dates, with at least two being weekends, to facilitate scheduling.
- Failure to Agree or Complete Match:
 - **Mutual Decision**: If players cannot agree on a match date or fail to complete the match by the deadline, they must mutually decide who will advance and inform the Competition Committee.
 - **Coin Toss Procedure**: If no mutual decision is reached:
 - **Notification**: Both players must inform the Competition Committee of the impasse before the round's deadline.
 - **Execution**: The Competition Committee will conduct a coin toss to determine who progresses.
 - **Finality**: The coin toss result is binding.
 - **Elimination**: If neither player communicates or proposes reasonable dates, both will be eliminated, and their next-round opponent receives a bye.

5. Extensions

- **Policy**: Extensions are generally not permitted to ensure fairness and adherence to the tournament schedule.
- **Exceptions**: The Competition Committee may grant short extensions in exceptional circumstances, such as medical emergencies. Personal holidays are not considered valid reasons for extensions.





6. Match Play Guidelines

- **Rules Adherence**: All matches must comply with the official Rules of Golf and any local course regulations.
- Pre-Match Agreements: Before starting, players should:
 - **Handicap Calculation**: Confirm the strokes to be conceded based on handicap differences.
 - The maximum allowable **Handicap Index** for **participants** is **28.0**
 - Matches are to be played from the **yellow tees of the day**, unless both players agree to use a different tee.
 - **Tiebreak Procedures**: Agree on methods to resolve ties, considering course availability and mutual preferences.

Tiebreak Methods:

- **Sudden Death**: If a match is tied after 18 holes, continue playing additional holes until a winner emerges.
- Alternative Solutions: If extending play isn't feasible:
 - **Replay Last Hole**: Play the final hole again.
 - Skill Contests: Engage in a putting or chipping competition.
 - **Driving Range Challenge**: Compete in a designated challenge at the driving range.
 - **Coin Toss**: As a last resort, determine the winner by a coin toss.

7. Reporting Match Results

- **Timely Submission**: The match winner must report the result within 24 hours via Golf Genius or by informing the Competition Committee, accompanied by the scorecard.
- **Consequences of Delay**: Failure to report promptly may lead to the reversal of the match outcome.
- **Scorecard Submission**: All scorecards should be shared with the Committee through WhatsApp.

8. General Terms

- **Oversight**: The Competition Committee is responsible for all aspects of the championship. Decisions made by the Committee are final and binding for all participants.
